
New electric vehicle charging points in the city

We want Edinburgh to become a net-zero city by 2030. Transport is one of the biggest contributors to greenhouse gas emissions. So, to help more people get around the city cleaner and greener, we're putting in more electric vehicle (EV) charging points.

Charging point locations

We already run EV chargers in the city. We're now putting in 81 more charging points with 141 charging bays which should be ready to use by summer 2022 at:

- Comely Bank Terrace/Avenue
- East London Street
- Fettes Avenue
- Heriot Row
- Hermiston Park and Ride
- Ingliston Park and Ride
- King's Road
- Maxwell Street
- Montgomery Street
- Sheriff Brae
- Stewart Terrace
- Thirlestane Road.









We're putting in three types of charging points

7kW standard	£o.25 per kWh, maximum stay 4 to 12 hours
22kW fast	£o.30 per kWh, maximum stay 3 hours
50kW rapid	£o.35 per kWh, maximum stay 30 minutes

How to use them

You just need to create an account with ChargePlace Scotland at account.chargeplacescotland.org/register. It's free and quick to create an account. When you create an account, you can order a smart card for £10 and download the ChargePlace Scotland app.

You do not need to reserve a charging point. You can see a map of charging locations, types, costs and availability at chargeplacescotland.org

Parking

We want as many people as possible to use our chargers, so please only use a charging bay to charge your electric vehicle. If your vehicle is parked in a charging bay and not plugged in, you will receive a parking ticket.

Please also move your vehicle before the maximum stay period is exceeded. If you do not, you will be charged a £30 overstay penalty. You also cannot return to a charging bay within four hours. If you do, you may receive a parking ticket.
